Carter #1420**, who, being duly sworn deposes and says that he has reason to believe and does believe that one **Jeffrey Alan Burrell**, described as follows: Last Known Address: **4333 Bluegrass Dr.**; Race: **White**; Sex: **Male**; DOB: **11/17/1953**; Ht: **6'00"**; Wt: **175**; Hair: **Salt and Pepper**; Eyes: **Blue**; Scars, Marks: **Unknown**; did in Nassau County, Florida, on **August 26, 2022**, commit the below-listed offense(s), contrary to the provisions of Florida Statutes:

- 1 847.0135 (3)(a) - Soliciting a Child for Unlawful Sexual Conduct using a Computer
- 2 934.215 - Unlawful use of a Two Way Communications Device

Affiant's reasons for so believing are as follows:

Your affiant has two and a half years' experience with the Nassau County Sheriff's Office with a total of eighteen and a half years of experience in law enforcement. Your affiant is currently assigned to the investigations division.

An operation was conducted with the assistance of the FBI involving communications with individuals wishing to seek sexual acts with underage children. During this operation, the defendant, Mr. Jeffrey Alan Burrell, answered an advertisement on an online website where by communicating with the purported victim. The purported victim disclosed she was 14 years old; however, the defendant continued communicating stating [REDACTED]. The following day, the defendant asked if the purported victim was "still around" and inquired if she was still "interested in getting together". The purported victim responded stating she was still free but "u freaked about my age soooo". Later, the defendant stated [REDACTED]. However, the defendant stated [REDACTED]. The initial arrangement was for the defendant to pay the purported victim \$80 for the sex act; however, the defendant stated [REDACTED]. The defendant disclosed [REDACTED]. The defendant communicated his wish to travel to see the purported victim stating he was in Brunswick Georgia at the time. Moreover, the defendant stated [REDACTED] but the purported victim [REDACTED]. Again in the conversation, the defendant asked [REDACTED]. Later, the communication ended after the defendant disclosed he had arrived at a predetermined location to meet the purported victim. However, the defendant was not immediately taken into custody.
